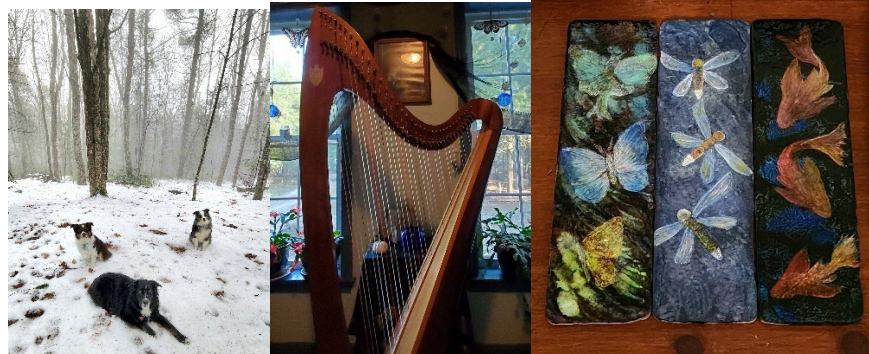

Norse winter "oracle days" center around the major seasonal festivals like Yule, Vetrnætr and Rauhnächte (Twelve Nights) for prophecy, reflection, and connecting with spirits, this entire time period is focused on the turning of seasons, rebirth, and honoring the gods/ancestors through feasting, rituals, and stories. This time of year also honors the Scandinavian practice of Hygge. The concept of Hygge can be traced back to the Middle Ages, where a similar Old Norse word meant "protected from the outside world." 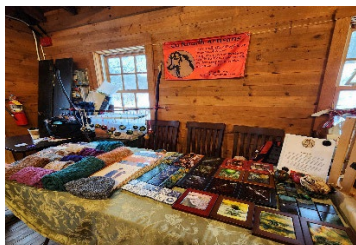
